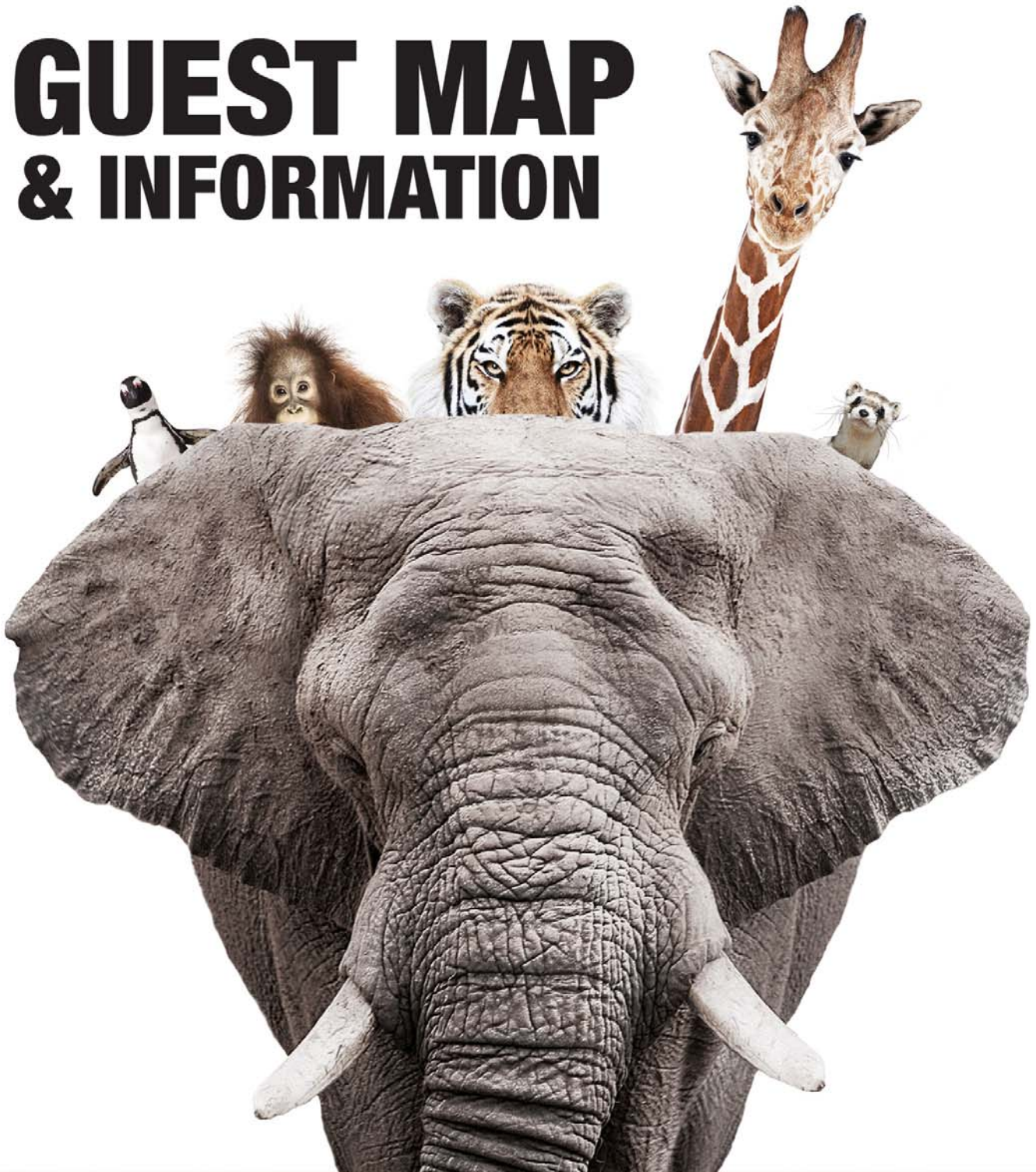

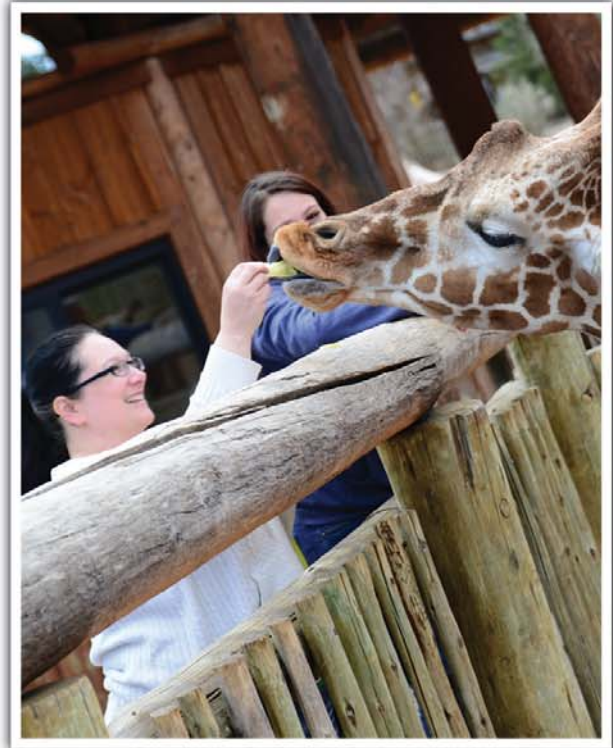
NATURAL BEHAVIOR SHOWS

GUEST INFORMATION

GUEST RULES

- Not permitted in the Zoo: pets, bicycles, skates, skateboards, roller blades, portable radios.
- The Zoo is a non-smoking facility, except in designated locations (see map inside). Cigarettes, e-cigarettes and nicotine vapor devices are allowed only in our smoking areas.
- Public marijuana consumption is illegal, and therefore not permitted anywhere on Zoo property.
- Children must be under adult supervision.
- Do not feed Zoo animals, unless food is purchased at feeding experience areas.
- For your safety and the safety of the animals, never feed wildlife.
- For your safety, do not cross guest barriers; stay on public pathways.

ZOO SHUTTLE

Need help getting around the Zoo? A golf-cart shuttle around the Zoo is available on most spring and summer days. It runs on a continuous loop and stops at the designated shuttle stop signs around the Zoo. The cost is \$2 per person and includes an all-day hand stamp. Purchase shuttle rides at Zoo admissions or with the shuttle driver. Wheelchair- and stroller-friendly. (On days when the shuttle is not making continuous loops, shuttle service is available upon request.)

WILL ROGERS SHRINE OF THE SUN

A trip to this historic monument — only 1.4 miles up Cheyenne Mountain — is included in your Zoo admission price for the day. Just drive to the Zoo entrance gate, show your admission receipt and follow the main road up the mountain (watch for signs). The last admission is at 4 p.m.

Please note that the speed limit through the Zoo is 5 m.p.h. Guest parking is not permitted within the Zoo.

MOUNTAINEER SKY RIDE

Soar over the Zoo in a chairlift-style, open-air ride that offers spectacular views of the surrounding mountains and Colorado Springs. The round-trip ride takes approximately seven minutes each way. The overview at the top offers awe-inspiring vistas, a rock-climbing wall and playground, restrooms and concessions (seasonal). Admission is \$5 for adults and \$4 for children ages 3-11. Access into the Zoo is not available from the top and walking down from the top is not allowed. Open as weather permits.

Last ride time is at 4:30 p.m.
