Colombian Firm Achieves RSPO Next

Daabon Group has attained the first RSPO Next certification, an achievement seen by observers as early signs of a shift towards rising palm oil certification standards.

Manuel Julian Dávila, chief executive officer of Daabon, said in a statement that "this achievement reconfirms Daabon's commitment to sustainability and RSPO".

He added: "We are especially proud to be the first group globally, together with our 122 small farmers, to show that RSPO

Next certification is challenging, but doable, also for smallholders."

Grégory Bardiès, market transformation manager, WWF Singapore, praises the message this certification sends to other companies. "The fact that standards continue to be raised sends a strong signal to other companies that getting certified is becoming an industry standard, not an option."
