

Why we buy Sugarcane Paper Products!

Renewable Resource - 1 year vs 30 years

Sugarcane takes only one year to reach maturity, as opposed to trees, which take up to 30 years.

Reused and Not Burned - Make Paper not Waste

The raw stalk pulp is used after the "Cane Sugar" is extracted, thereby reusing an already "used" resource. Previously, the excess crushed stalks were burned.

100% Compostable - Made from Nature, Returned to Nature

Sugarcane paper products turn back into dirt in as little as 45 days in a commercial composting facility.

FAQs

"Will it make my food sweeter?"

No, Sugar Cane products do not retain any of the sweetness of the plant.

"Can I eat it?"

We don't recommend it, however it is just paper, so it wouldn't cause much harm.

"How is this different than a Chinet or other fiber plate?"

Our plates are made from a 100% annually-renewable resource, sugar cane. Other fiber plates are typically made from trees.
