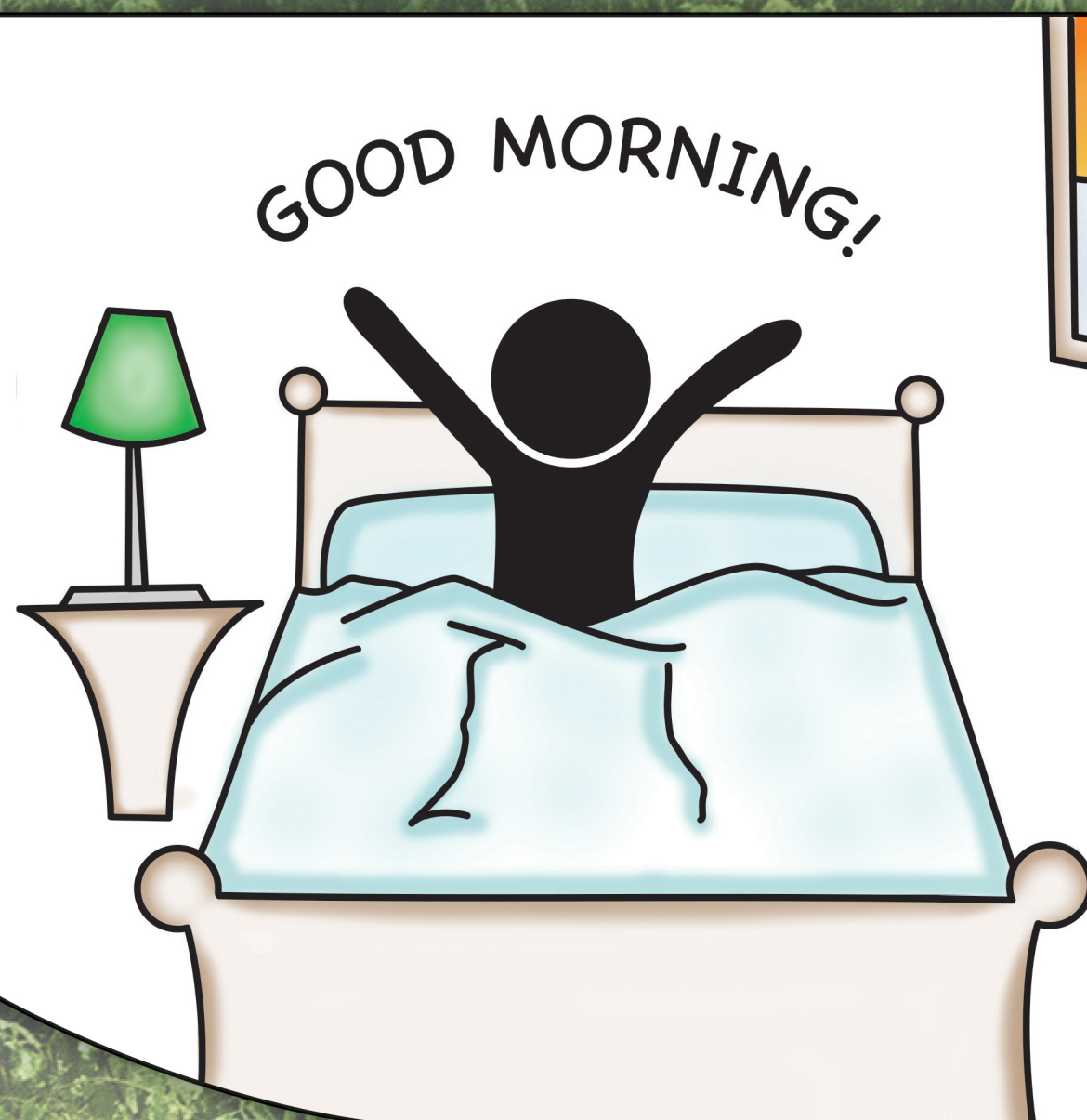
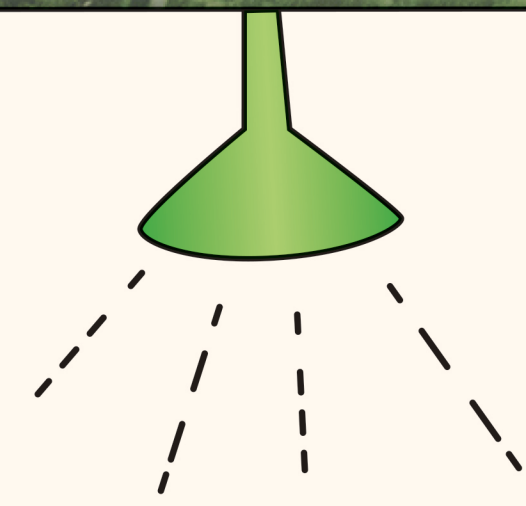

Many popular soap, shampoo, conditioner and toothpaste products contain palm oil.

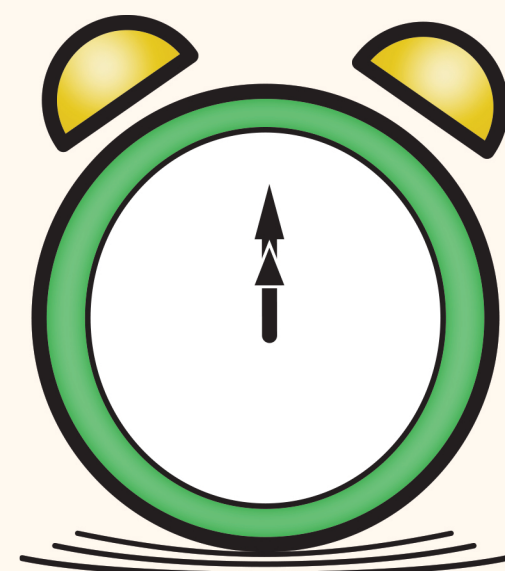


YOUR MORNING ROUTINE

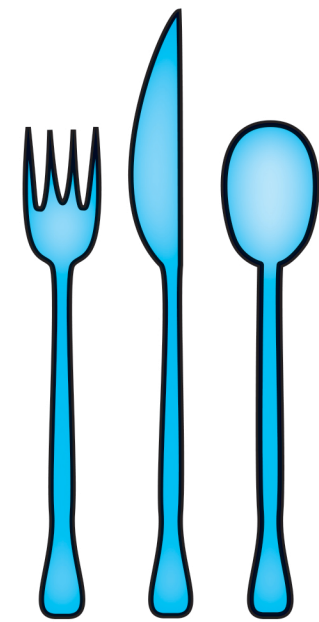
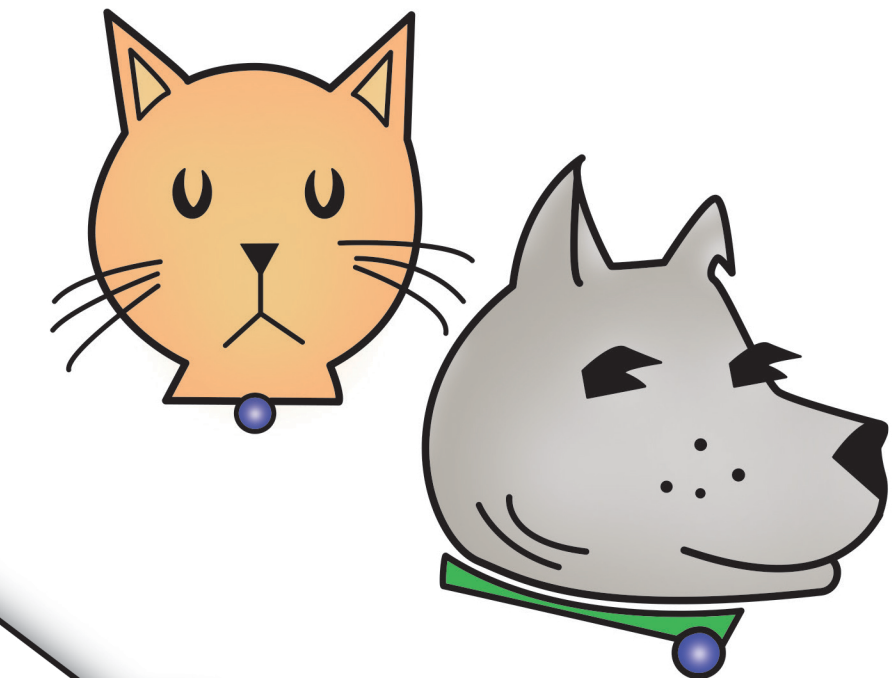
The foods you eat for breakfast, like oatmeal, cereal, donuts and cereal bars, can all contain palm oil.
