2016 RSPO Impact Report Released

Highlights of the report include:

- An overall increase of 9% in the total area set aside for conservation to a total area equal to 200,000 soccer fields.
- Out of 63 complaint cases since 2009, 41 have either been closed or are closed for monitoring.
- The number of RSPO members increased 29% since 2015.
 - 45% membership increase in U.S.
 - 43% increase in Australia
