RSPO ACOPs Due May 19, 2017

The Annual Communications of Progress (ACOP) are reports submitted by RSPO members to gauge their progress towards 100% RSPO-certified sustainable palm oil. These reports are mandatory for Ordinary and Affiliate members, and are submitted each year.

The reporting period for the 2016 ACOP due in May is Jan. 1, 2016 through Dec. 31, 2016. Previously the ACOP reporting period went from July 1 to June 30 of the following year, but since the report on 2014 it has been a calendar year span.

ACOPs are valuable to consumers as they give real numbers of certified sustainable palm oil being used. Including the total
